



Application Process

NOTE: Each application submission is evaluated and assessed to determine the applicants' readiness and potential success in the program. Completing the minimum prerequisite requirements does not guarantee a seat in an intake. Decisions regarding enrollment are made solely at the discretion of WCCMT's Admissions Panel and *are final*.

Applications will be reviewed with equal opportunity for acceptance into the program. Applications must be complete and meet minimum prerequisite requirements before a required education interview is scheduled. Every attempt should be made to complete your application as early as possible.

Please follow the instructions below carefully to ensure processing without delay. A complete application, which meets all requirements, does not constitute a guarantee of acceptance.

1. To start an application, complete the application form, submit a minimum of one (1) application item and pay the \$100 non-refundable application fee. We recommend submitting your essay as the first application item.
2. Once your application has been processed, an email will be sent to you regarding the **\$2,500** enrollment fee and term 1 contract. This enrollment fee and contract must be submitted 10 business days after you apply. Please note the refund policies outlined on Page 4 PRIOR to signing your Term 1 contract. The signed and dated contract must be submitted to the Admissions Coordinator with your enrollment fee on the due date stated in the email. If you have questions regarding your enrollment fee or contract, please contact the Admissions Coordinator.
3. Once the enrollment fee is paid you qualify to be set up on the online Anatomy & Physiology preparatory course. This course must be completed before your final educational interview and is done at your own pace. We are not looking for certain grades, but we do expect you to chip away at it and you will be asked about it in your interview. Completion of this course will be taken into consideration when determining your acceptance.
4. A sit-in schedule will be sent to you via email. This schedule will outline which classes are available to audit. Sitting in on classes will be taken into consideration when determining your acceptance into our program and will work in your favor. It is expected that you take advantage of this opportunity.
5. You must submit a full and complete application by the following hard deadlines:
January intakes: November 15th
September intakes: July 15th
6. Once you complete your application and submit your Interview Questionnaire (sent to you in an email once you finish your application) your file will be passed to the Campus Director who will then contact you to schedule your interview. Make sure you have reviewed the college policies that were sent to you with the interview questionnaire.
7. After your final interview is complete the WCCMT Admissions Panel will decide on your acceptance into the program. Should you be accepted, you will be notified via email and sent a hard copy acceptance letter in the mail. If you should be rejected, you will be notified via email. Decisions regarding enrollment are made solely at the discretion of WCCMT's Admissions Panel and *are final*.
